

SUVLA SYRAH 2015



The wine is produced from Syrah grapes grown on the family vineyard Bozokbag in the Gallipoli Peninsula. The vineyard has hardpan soil. Northwest winds prevailing the micro climate provide a highly convenient terrior of the maturation of high quality grapes.

Suvla Syrah 2015 is an intense red wine with fragrant aromas of dried fig, black olive with layers of spices, vanilla and laurel. The explosion of fruit and spice nuances is accented by a background of violet notes.

The wine is well-balanced, fleshy and exhibits velvety tannins. The palate has ripe blackberry and dried fruit flavours, escalating to a long and exuberant finish.

Climate: In general the Aegean region has a mild climate. However, it becomes harsher at altitude. Temperatures can rise to 40°C during summer and fall to -10 °C in winter. There are about 80 days

Soil: Hardpan soil at 167 metres (above sea level)

Berry: Dark blue/ black colour, small to medium sized, round berries with thick skin

Ripening: Mid-season.
